Global AI Legislation

SESSION DESCRIPTION

Principles, practices, then passed laws – the world is seeing a shift in the global AI regulatory conversation as legislators begin to draft, enact, and implement omnibus AI laws. For example, the EU AI Act implementation is reaching full speed, and new AI laws are either being adopted (South Korea), quickly advancing (Brazil), or being prepared (Japan and China). At the same time, <u>some have suggested</u> that fast-moving AI tech, business practices, and individuals' engagement with AI tools should prompt policymakers to revisit and hone aspects of the AI Act.

What factors and considerations drive the substance and form of these Al laws? Are there emerging patterns that might be discerned from these jurisdictions' regulatory approaches? What strategies and best practices can companies across industries take to address global compliance challenges effectively? This session will look comparatively across jurisdictions to discuss implications, emerging compliance strategies, and best practices across industries.

- 4. What are the biggest compliance challenges you face in navigating Al laws across multiple jurisdictions?
- **5.** How are your companies adjusting their Al governance strategies to keep pace with—or future—proof against—evolving Al regulations and regulatory approaches?
- **6.** What strategies and best practices can companies across industries take to address global compliance challenges effectively?
